Hollywood Came to Everglades City!

In the fall of 1957, producer Budd Schulberg and his crew moved in to film "Wind Across the Everglades" which he wrote after meeting Bud Kirk, a Marco man, and listening to stories about nefarious activities in the Everglades.

Stars of the movie were big Burl Ives, a young Christopher Plummer, and Gypsy Rose Lee. They bedded down in the Rod & Gun, sometimes causing a bit of chaos with their carousing.

Local residents were roped into playing bit parts, including Totch Brown. What is now McLeod Park was transformed into an old street with phony store fronts *(photo below)* and the Depot bore a sign proclaiming it was in Miami.
